



Survey shows women's security hardly a priority for organisations

Just about 3% of organisations in South **Mumbai** appear to care for women's security at the workplace, says a survey conducted recently.

Conducted at Mumbai's business district of **Nariman Point** and the upcoming business district at Lower Parel, the survey showed that even organisations which are aware of the Sexual **Harassment** of Women at the Workplace (Prevention, **Prohibition** Redressal) Act, 2013 do not know how to comply with it.

The survey was done by Complykaro, a group formed to assist companies and organisations to implement and execute provisions of the law.
